Elmira, NY | Watkins Glen, NY – The Arc Chemung-Schuyler was grateful to learn they were part of a generous donation announced by Tom Golisano at a press event held on September 17, 2024.

Mr. Golisano announced that he is donating \$360 million to 82 non-profit organizations in Rochester, Buffalo, and Syracuse, New York with 26 organizations in the field of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD) receiving \$104 Million.
