

Joanne S. Hayes Memorial Scholarship

The Arc Chemung-Schuyler offers the Joanne S. Hayes Memorial scholarship, a \$1,000 award, to one graduating senior whose chosen field of study will enable him or her to have a positive impact on the lives of people with disabilities.

Joanne Hayes was a past board member and president prior to her death in 1987. This education fund is a fitting tribute to her commitment to The Arc.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. The recipient must be a graduating senior from Watkins Glen, Odessa-Montour, or Bradford Central Schools OR must be a graduating senior who is a Schuyler County resident pursing education elsewhere.
- 2. The recipient must plan to pursue their education in the field of special education, human services, or a related clinical area such as nursing, psychology, speech pathology, or physical/occupational therapy.
- 3. The scholarship application must be completed in its entirety and submitted with all requested attachments.
- 4. Completed applications must be received on or before <u>Friday, May 16, 2025</u>. Students attending Watkins Glen, Odessa-Montour, or Bradford Central Schools should return their completed applications to the high school guidance office. Students pursuing education elsewhere should submit in person or mail their completed applications to: The Arc Chemung-Schuyler, 711 Sullivan Street, Elmira, NY 14901.

Method of Selection of Scholarship Winners/Rules

- 1. Candidates will be evaluated and selected by a committee of at least four members.
- 2. Candidates will be scored in the following areas:
 - Career goals related to the support of youth and/or adults with intellectual, developmental, or other disabilities.
 - Academic achievement (academic improvement and/or maintenance of high average through high school)
 - Extra-curricular activities (athletics, fine arts, volunteer projects, work experience, etc.)
 - Essay quality (please respond to all components of the essay and proofread)
 - Additional points will be awarded to applicants who tour The Arc Chemung-Schuyler to learn first-hand about its programs and services prior to, or when, submitting the application. - 3. Winners will be recognized at June graduation ceremonies.
- 4. The recipient is eligible to receive the award upon returning to college for the second school semester of his/her first year. The one-time award will be given in the form of a check by The Arc Chemung-Schuyler when The Arc is notified by the recipient that he/she is eligible. Copies of college transcripts and/or other proof of continued enrollment will be required at that time.
- 5. The recipient must be willing to provide his/her current photo to The Arc Chemung-Schuyler, to be used in internal/external communications promoting the Joanne S. Hayes Memorial Scholarship.
